### **Discussion Items:**

A public meeting was held to discuss the Baranmor Ditch Watershed Outfall Systems Plan (OSP) Phase A alternatives analysis. While this summary is not intended to represent a comprehensive account of the meeting, it is intended to reflect the key points raised and issues for further consideration resulting from the discussions.

1. Ken MacKenzie provided an overview of UDFCD and the major drainageway master planning/outfall systems planning process.
2. A PowerPoint presentation was given, during which Deb Ohlinger provided an overview of the project and project driving factors.
3. Amy Gabor provided an overview of the study area and existing conditions and described the general nature of both the observed problems in the study area and the alternatives that were evaluated to remedy the observed problems. Additional detail was given for the components of the recommended alternative, including advantages and disadvantages of the recommended alternative.
4. Following the presentation a questions and answers session was held. Key components and issues that were discussed by the citizens and project team were as follows:
  - a) There were several questions relating to when components of the OSP would be implemented and if money is available for the improvements. Clint Weisz stated that there are funds available for capital improvements projects and that these projects are completed based on a priority ranking. Ken MacKenzie pointed out that once the OSP has been completed UDFCD can contribute money toward

implementing the plan and stated that the earliest anything could be done is next summer; although it is unlikely improvements will be implemented that soon.

- b) There were questions relating to the sequencing of improvements. Ken MacKenzie stated that UDFCD supports the City's decision as to which improvements would be completed first. Clint Weisz stated that it is likely that Peoria Street improvements would be completed first since it would provide the most benefit. The Peoria Street improvements are approximately half of the total improvements estimated cost.
- c) A question was raised regarding trees that have died on the south side of the ditch between Scranton Street and I-225 and who owns them.
- d) A resident asked if UDFCD could speak at a neighborhood meeting that has been planned in April. Ken MacKenzie said he would be willing and gave the resident his contact information.
