- 1) Please provide your name and preferred contact info, as well as the community/entity name that you are filling the survey out for.
- 2) For question 1, please fill out the table for all the hazard types listed.
In the first column, please indicate whether your community/entity is likely to experience the hazard indicated.
In the second column, please indicate the risk of experiencing the hazard in any given year.
Finally, please indicate your community/entity's vulnerability to the hazard in question (i.e. If a severe winter storm hit, would the damage be severe, limited, minimal, or unknown?).
- 3) Question 3 asks for potential projects you would like considered for your community. The following list gives a number of examples that have been included in plans for other communities. Please do not limit yourself to this list – if you have other projects in mind, feel free to include them. This plan can include any project that focuses on mitigation, or preventing damages to structures and protecting the lives of residents. Make sure when choosing the projects that will protect your community to concentrate on mitigation, not on recovery. Recovery projects are covered in separate planning efforts.
